NEWBORN – 3 MONTHS



- Briefly looks at objects
- Follows objects with eyes
- Begins to coo and laugh
- Tracks objects with eyes from side to side
- Responds with smile

3 – 6 MONTHS



- Enjoys frolic play
- Reaches for objects
- Extends arms toward an object
- Maintains head upright when placed on stomach
- Rolls from back to sides, then later from back to stomach

6 - 9 MONTHS



- Searches for hidden objects (object permanence)
- Reaches for objects

- Maintains balance in sitting while reaching for a toy

9 – 12 MONTHS



- Looks for hidden sounds
- Engages in means-to-end

- Seeks reaction from others

12 – 15 MONTHS



- Explores toys independently
- Begins to notice color
- Nests blocks inside each other
- Places circle in shape sorter
- Understands new words and attends to pictures (and shapes) when named
- Maintains balance in a kneeling position while reaching for objects

15 - 18 MONTHS



- Places one object inside another
- Uses trial and error skills
- Identifies objects by category

21 - 24 MONTHS
